Allshred Services reaches 100,000,000 pounds of paper shredded and recycled – FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

Maumee, OH – March 30, 2009. Allshred Services is very pleased to announce they have shredded and recycled over 100,000,000 pounds of paper. For the last 20 years, Allshred has tracked and recorded the amount of paper that has been shredded and recycled for customers. On Friday March 27, 2009 this number reached 100,053,034. As a result of using our services, our customers have all contributed to the 100,053,034 pounds of paper we have recycled. In doing so they have helped to save 850,453 trees, 350,186,690 gallons of water, 205,109,347 kwh of electricity, 19,010,135 gallons of oil, 165,088 cubic yards of landfill space and have kept 3,001,600 pounds of air effluents from the atmosphere.

On average Allshred Services shreds and recycles 1 million pounds of paper each month. We have the ability to provide Environmental Savings Reports to our customers that detail the number of trees, gallons of water and oil, kwh of electricity and landfill space they have helped save and the number of pounds of air effluents kept from the atmosphere as a result of using our services. Tom Huth, Vice President of Operations at Allshred Services, remarked, “Reaching 100,000,000 pounds of shredded and recycled paper during our 20th year of business is a great accomplishment. Allshred has also developed office policies that are geared toward reducing paper usage and has instituted an office-wide recycling program which includes all paper material, plastic and glass bottles and aluminum cans. All uniforms are washed in environmentally friendly laundry detergent and “green” cleaning products are used throughout the facility. Allshred is proud of its “green” initiatives and it is just another way to give back to the environment.
